

## *#Alpha's Summer Adventure*

### **July 3rd – July 7<sup>th</sup> #Friend Building:**

School's out for summer and the children are ready for the fun times to begin. The children will start off their summer adventures at camp by getting acquainted with new and returning camp participants. They will participate in some fun Friend-Building games such as Speed Friending Games, and then in the afternoon they will join in a fun shoe talk activity. On Wednesday the children will connect with others while taking part in a sharing circle to help learn more about each other. In the afternoon the campers will partake in an information scrum as they test their memory to see how well they remember what they learned about the other campers. Thursday the children will participate in a fun game of "Who Am I?" as they try to guess the child they are talking about. In the afternoon, the children will get to view the latest movie being screened at the Orion Gate Cineplex Movie Theatre. Friday the campers will end their week joining in the Human Mandela activity and then afterwards they will relax with some nice warm tea and crumpets. In the afternoon, the children will cool down and enjoy splashing in the water at the local splash pad.

### **July 10<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> #Our World:**

Alpha campers will get their creative juices flowing as they learn more about Mystic Drumz and then in the afternoon they will express their creative side by making some international crafts. Tuesday, the campers will learn more about their heritage as they visit the Peel Art Museum. After lunch the children will put on a Cultural Dress Fashion Show for the other children in the centre. Wednesday the children will need to be prepared to face our world head-on as they create a BIG World Mural and then get pumped up as they participate in some fun International games. Thursday the children will challenge themselves with a Country Fact sheet and test their knowledge about their Cultural Heritage, and in the afternoon they will join in some cultural baking or cooking to share with each other. The campers will end the week having a World Dance Party, enjoy a Cultural Potluck lunch and in the afternoon the children will get rejuvenated at the local splash pad.

### **July 17<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> #Alpha's Active Kids:**

The campers will prepare themselves for the week as they start off rejuvenating their inner self by learning some basic Yoga and then in the afternoon test their endurance skills by competing in a Bocce (lawn bowling) Competition. Tuesday the children will participate in a fun and friendly game of Dodgeball and then after lunch they will play in a Baseball game at the local park. On Wednesday, the children will get active and participate in fun games at Chinguacousy Park and then in the afternoon have a friendly game of mini-golf. Thursday, the campers will test their hand-eye coordination as they participate in a fun game of Glow in the Dark laser tag at the Glow Zone and then test their endurance in a game of soccer baseball. The campers will end the week as they push their physical fitness to the limit as they participate in our Gym Challenge and then relax and cool down at the local splash pad.

### **July 24<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> #Tool Time!:**

The camp builders will begin this week participating in an activity that will help boost the campers' self-esteem as they participate in "The Good Stuff" Game where they will share good characteristics about each other. Then in the afternoon they will prepare for the next day's "Block it up with Lego" Challenge by creating blueprints for their own Lego creation. On Tuesday the children will build their Lego creation for the Block Challenge, and then after lunch they will make their own ice cream sundae. Wednesday the children will express their creativity and sculpt some abstract art masterpieces, and then in the afternoon they will get their hands dirty doing some polymer clay. Thursday the children will get in touch with nature as they visit the Humber Arboretum. They will learn to navigate in the woods by learning how to read maps and in the afternoon, they will discover how to track down wildlife by understanding more about the growth and changes in animals. On Friday the children will create and build their own sub sandwich for lunch in the morning, and then cool off at the local splash pad.

### **July 31<sup>st</sup> - Aug. 4<sup>th</sup> #Water Works:**

The campers will get wet and wild as they start their week displaying their creative side doing some Kool-Aid art and then compete in a water balloon toss in order to see who can stay dry the longest. After lunch, they will test their taste buds and participate in a flavoured water taste test. Tuesday the children will create their very own watercolour painting, and then in the afternoon create their own lemonade/popcorn stand. On Wednesday the children will sell lemonade/popcorn and all proceeds will go towards the Brampton Urgent Care Centre. Thursday the campers will have fun challenging each other in some sponge races, and then in the afternoon they will create their very own lava lamp. The children will end their week painting a portrait of their friend, and then they will cool off at the local splash pad.

**Aug. 7<sup>th</sup> – Aug. 11<sup>th</sup> #Animal Kingdom:**

The campers will begin the week on Tuesday putting their acting skills to the test as they get in touch with their inner animal and participate in a game of “Animal Charades”. The children will end their week as they put their artistic talents to the test doing some fun animal face painting, and then they will take a walk on the wild side and relax at the local splash pad.
