Word from the Office

Welcome to all of our new families who are joining us or have joined us over the summer months. I know working together as a team, we will be able to provide the best quality program possible. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to approach me at any time.



Alpha believes in taking learning outdoors therefore all of the children spend one hour in the morning and one hour in the afternoon outside in our fenced in playground. It is important that the children have appropriate clothing in order to enjoy and participate in the activities set up for them. For the fall weather the children will need a pair of puddle boots, splash pants, a jacket preferably with a hood or a warm hat and gloves as the weather becomes cooler towards October time. Please be sure to label each piece of clothing with your child's name and/or initials to ensure that all clothing are placed in the proper cubbies.

Alpha has purchased many new items for the centre which include a shed for the Toddler play ground to store their materials, 4 new area rugs for the classrooms, 2 sensory bins for the School Age program, new shelves for the Jr. Toddler program, a leather couch some lounge for the School Agers, 2 wagons, picnic benches for outdoors and some natural materials for the children to explore.

In doing our long-term planning for the year, Christmas Eve falls on a Monday as does New Year's Eve, Alpha is only ever open on these days until 3:00 p.m. but this year Alpha will be using their floating holiday (as per the parent agreement) for 2018 for the Christmas Eve day and their floating holiday for 2019 for the New Years Eve day. Alpha does not always use the floating holiday every year but the way the Christmas holidays fall this year Alpha would like to cash in on them in order to give the educators some well-deserved extra time off. Alpha will be closed on Monday December 24, 2018, (Christmas Eve) Tuesday December 25, 2018 (Christmas Day) and Wednesday December 26, 2018 (Boxing Day). We will be open regular hours on Thursday December 27, 2018 and Friday December 28, 2018. We will be closed Monday December 31, 2018 (New Year's Eve) and January 1, 2019 (New Year's Day). We will be open regular hours on Wednesday January 2, Thursday January 3, and Friday January 4, 2019. Please see me if there are any concerns with this schedule.





communication with all my School Age children's families and provide the best of my ability! We are all a team!
