- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 ½ teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- · 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3 cups quick cooking oats
- nonstick cooking spray with flour
- 2 tablespoons water
- 2 tablespoons white sugar, or as needed

#### **Directions**

Instructions Checklist

- 1. Whisk flour, cinnamon, baking soda, and salt together in a medium bowl until well combined.
- 2. Beat butter, 1 cup white sugar, and brown sugar in a large bowl with an electric mixer until creamy, at least 2 to 3 minutes. Beat in eggs, one at a time, then mix in vanilla. Gradually mix in dry ingredients until well combined. Add oats and mix until thoroughly incorporated. Cover the bowl and chill dough in the refrigerator for at least 1
- 3. When ready to bake, preheat

the oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C). Spray two cookie sheets with floured cooking spray. Place water in a small bowl and 2 tablespoons sugar in another small bowl.

- Roll chilled dough into walnut-sized balls, and place 2 inches apart on the prepared cookie sheets. Dip a large fork in water, then in sugar, and use to flatten each cookie, rewetting and re-sugaring as necessary.
- 5. Bake in the preheated oven until light golden brown

around the edges and centers are nearly set, 8 to 10 minutes, switching racks halfway through. Allow cookies to cool on baking sheet for 5 minutes before transferring to a wire rack to cool completely.

- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- Mix well in mixer all wet
   ingredients along with sugar
   and then add all dry ingredients.

Mix for 2 minutes

- Line muffin tins with baking cups liners
- 3. And 1 full scoop of batter to each cup.
- 4. Bake at 350 for 22 minutes
